

GHA: COVID-19 Information Leaflet

You are receiving this leaflet because you (or your dependent, if you are the carer) has had a COVID-19 test.

If your COVID-19 test is POSITIVE / DETECTED then in addition to isolating (10 days, or 7 days if testing negative on day 6 & 7 by lateral flow), to ensure your (or your dependent's) optimal care & support it is extremely important you contact 111 **IF**:

You (or your dependent) are in any of the following high-risk groups:

- 1) Down's syndrome
- 2) Sickle Cell Disease
- 3) You currently have active cancer and have received treatment for cancer in the last 12 months (chemotherapy in past 12 months or radiotherapy in past 6 months)
- 4) You have leukaemia or lymphoma or myeloma or have had treatment for these or other blood cancers in the last 12 months or have received a stem cell or bone marrow transplant for any reason. Other haematological diseases that require immunosuppressant treatment (e.g., aplastic anaemia, paroxysmal nocturnal haemoglobinuria)
- 5) You have severe kidney failure, are on dialysis or have had a kidney transplant
- 6) You have severe liver disease or have had a liver transplant
- 7) You have an immune/ auto-immune disease which is treated with immunosuppressant drugs
- 8) You have a diagnosed immune deficiency syndrome
- 9) You have HIV
- 10) You have received an organ transplant (heart, lungs, pancreas etc).
- 11) You have one of the following neurological conditions: Multiple sclerosis, Motor neurone disease, Myasthenia gravis or Huntington's disease.

If you (or your dependent) meet any of these criteria, then call 111 as soon as possible.

Please note, the GHA Contact Tracing Bureau will call all positive cases as soon as possible but they may not have access to all the above details and at times, due to volume of testing, there may be a delay of up to 24 hours for a phone call.
